# Energy WASTE



About 15 Million tons of CO<sub>2</sub> are emitted each year in order to power outdoor lighting

In Commercial buildings alone where annual electricity costs are roughly £190 billion about 30 percent of this energy goes to waste.

Small House £184 per year  
Medium House £1153 per year  
Large House £1824 per year  
This was in 2014!



If you recycle paper instead of making it out of new raw materials, you save about 70% of the energy needed. The amount of energy wasted by the USA in 2012 could power the UK for 7 years. The energy saved from recycling one glass bottled jar is enough to power your computer for 20 Mins
